THE COMMITTEE DISCUSSED AVERAGE RENTS AND LEASES OF AGRICULTURAL LAND IN CHAMBERS COUNTY. COMMITTEE MEMBERS AGREED AVERAGE RENTS FOR IRRIGATED CROPS SHOULD REMAIN THE SAME AT \$25.00, DRYLAND CROP SHOULD REMAIN AT \$5.00, IMPROVED PASTURE SHOULD BE \$5.00, NATIVE PASTURE SHOULD STILL BE \$4.50, MARSH & WASTE SHOULD BE \$4.00, CRAWFISH FARMS SHOULD BE \$15.00, ORCHARDS SHOULD BE \$10.00, GRASS FARMS SHOULD BE \$35.00, TIMBER SHOULD BE \$8.00, HUNTING LEASES SHOULD BE \$8.00 AND BEES SHOULD BE \$7.50.

ACCORDING TO THE COMMITTEE, TAXES ARE INCLUDED IN THE LEASE PRICE.
